# **PREP SCHOOL TASTER DAY**



Taster days are an integral part of the admissions process at Mowden Hall School and we recommend all pupils have at least one. A Taster Day allows a child to visit the school as a pupil for a school day during term time; to study and play alongside future classmates. Children are able to gain an understanding of the school's ethos and routines, and, perhaps most importantly, diminish those 'first day of term' anxieties.

Care is taken to find out as much as possible about a prospective pupils' strengths and interests beforehand, so that he or she can visit on a school day that is rich with the lessons and activities of particular interest to the child. Overnight taster days are also possible so that children whose families are considering boarding can experience a full 24 hour visit. Taster days do not incur a cost and all meals are included whether your child is on a day or boarding taster experience.

We do not need a registration form at this stage, but we do need our online medical form to be completed.

A programme is sent in advance, tailored to your child.

- The day starts at 8.20am

- Throughout the day we will be gathering insight and feedback from the Mowden team
- At pick-up a member of the team will provide an overview of the day

- Our day finishes at 5.15pm. If an overnight session is booked your child would also experience prep and evening activities, a highlight of the day for many of our pupils.

# Medical

Should your child have any specific medical concerns you would like to discuss prior to their visit, please contact our school Nurse, Mrs. Laura Danby (Idanby@mowdenhallpst.org) and complete this online <u>Medical Form</u> before their arrival. If possible, please could your child take a Lateral Flow test before arriving.

# Drop off & Pick Up

Please can you aim to drop off circa 8.15am. Our School day commences at 8.20am. Staff will be outside the main building on the drive (at the large speed bump), and your child will be taken to their classroom by their Form Tutor and guide. Pick up is at 5.15pm if staying for the full day.

### Equipment

Please can your child come dressed in his or her current school uniform and bring the following equipment with them (clearly named):

PE Kit and trainers, (games sessions are followed by showers, towels provided)

Pencil case

Reading book

Water bottle

Lunch, snacks, and refreshments will be provided. Please let us know if your children has any specific dietary requirements.
