#### Parents & Children

- Social distancing must be observed throughout the whole process, from entry to the swimming pool facility, changing rooms, during the lessons, post swim changing and exiting the facility
- All people must be 1 metres plus apart, excluding same household members
- Inform parents / guardians and swimmers that if
  they or a member of their household have a cold,
  fever, anosmia or any signs or symptoms of
  COVID-19 they are not to enter the swimming facility
  or attend swimming lessons. They should self-isolate
  for two weeks, therefore, are not permitted to
  attend swimming lessons for two weeks. We have
  completed detailed risk assessments and ensure all
  staff are trained on the risk assessment and new
  policy procedures to ensure the safety of our
  employees, customers and swimmers at all times.
- Please arrive at your allotted time and no earlier
- Please go directly to the pool, unfortunately, due to Covid regulations and safeguarding issues you are not permitted to walk around the grounds before, after, or in between siblings' lessons.
- One adult per child only at this time, either in the pool or to spectate
- Please wear foot coverings, or flip flops or similar footwear poolside.

### Cleaning



- Lessons are 30 minutes long with 15 minutes inbetween classes to allow the teacher to sanitise equipment and for the safe movement of people between lessons
- An external cleaner will clean every 3 hours with a deep clean at the start and end of the day
- Ensure everyone sanitises their hands upon entrance and exit of the venue
- Equipment will be sanitised after each lesson

### Teaching



- Teachers will deliver classes from poolside where possible
- Adults and children must arrive pool ready and shower at home
- Parents must remind their child regarding social distancing
- Toys will be designated to each swimmer at the start of the lesson with no sharing
- Extensive risk assessments and staff training
